

Bridport Planning Commission Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Ed Payne at 7:20 PM.

General Public present: Kent Wright of Bridport.

A motion was made by Ed Payne, seconded by JoAnne Kenyon to accept the October 10, 2017 minutes as presented. The motion passed.

Old Business: The Commission continued to review the "Rules of Procedure and Conflict of Interest Policy I" document from the last meeting and agreed to make the following two minor grammatical changes to the document:

Page 1, Section II: Policy, 1st sentence to read: *These Rules are adopted to ensure consistent and fair treatment of applicants, interested persons, and participants; orderly and efficient public proceedings, and compliance with state and federal law.*

Page 5, Section VII: paragraph E. to read: *Explain that, pursuant to 24 V.S.A. 447(a), an interested person who has participated in a municipal regulatory proceeding authorized under this title may appeal a decision rendered in that proceeding.*

A motion was made by JoAnne Kenyon and seconded by Andrew Manning to approve these two minor changes to this document. The motion passed.

New Business: The Commission agreed to take up a review of the Bridport "SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS" document at the next meeting.

As there was no other business to bring up, Ed Payne adjourned the meeting at 8:20 PM.
