TOWN HIGHWAY ACCESS PERMIT

REQUIREMENTS: THIS PERMIT IS ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 19, SECTION 1111, VERMONT STATUTES ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO ALL HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CONTROL AND JURISDICTION OF BRIDPORT. THE ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT DOES NOT RELEASE THE LANDOWNER(S) FROM ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF STATUTES, ORDINANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE OF VERMONT OR ANY OTHER GOVERNMENT AND/OR OF THE TOWN OF BRIDPORT, SUCH AS BRIDPORT SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS. THIS PERMIT WILL BE EFFECTIVE UPON COMPLIANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS AND CONTINUE IN EFFECT WHILE IN SUCH COMPLIANCE AND FOR AS LONG AS SAID

PROPOSED LAND USE CONTINUES. ANY CHANGE FROM SAID PROPOSED LAND USE WILL REQUIRE A NEW ACCESS PERMIT. THIS PERMIT IS ISSUED SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED HEREIN, INCLUDING ANY ATTACHMENT HERETO, AND COVERS ONLY THE WORK FOR THE ACCESS DESCRIBED HEREIN WHEN IT IS PERFORMED AS DIRECTED. VIOLATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES SET FORTH IN TITLE 19, SECTION 1111, V.S.A., OF NOT LESS THAN \$100.00 AND NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS ARE INCLUDED AS ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: IN GENERAL, THIS INCLUDES THE ACCESS BEING CONSTRUCTED AND MAINTAINED IN A MANNER SUCH THAT THE ACCESS DOES NOT ADVERSELY AFFECT THE USE OF THE SO ACCESSED TOWN HIGHWAY SUCH AS: (1) THE SURFACE OF THE ACCESS BEING SLOPED AND GRADED IN A WAY TO NOT ALLOW WATER TO DRAIN FROM THE ACCESS INTO THE TRAVELLED PORTION OF THE TOWN HIGHWAY, (2) NOT PLACING ANY MARKER, CURB OR ANYTHING ELSE THAT WOULD INTERFERE WITH SNOW PLOWING WITHIN _____ FEET OF THE TRAVELLED PORTION OF THE TOWN HIGHWAY, AND (3) KEEPING THE CULVERT FULLY OPEN FOR THE DRAINING OF WATER.
